Next week's phonics skill: /er/; /oo/ spelled oo and .ew; diphthongs; inflectional endings; contractions

Next week's spelling words: brag, bread, brick, bright, brush, free, frisky, frog, front, friend

Next week's sight words: another, new, said, there, would

Next week's sentence: The fox had a tail like a brush.
